Coach Carter -

- Monday (10/19) field practice begins - masks are required. Students attending class on campus may use locker room to change. Virtual students only attending practice must come in gear and are not allowed in the locker room
- Practice will utilize limited student pitching, coaches and machines will be used instead (until after Thanksgiving)
- Currently the only team meeting daily - players are working on mental conditioning
- School District Maintenance agreed the fence was a safety issue. \$6K was quoted to repair the fence. District ok'd the plan to utilize those funds to upgrade the fence to a wall. Anticipated cost is \$45-\$50K and construction should occur over Winter Break. Currently looking for a general contractor. School may be able to assist with wall cost if needed
- Consulted with several companies regarding field/grass.

15K -\$20K raised for scholarships, buses for finals

Grass consults completed, will be doing that. Some clean up will be needed for the field.

Homecoming postponed to Vandergrif game

Purchase Portal will be opening this fall for parents wishing to get items for Christmas gifts. A second one will open prior to baseball season as well.
