I. Review of Previous Minutes

2. Special Events – Carolina Rodriguez said that \$54 was raised for the Chipotle spirit night. There will be a Spirit Night at Hopdoddy tomorrow night and they will donate 20%. Kendra Scott will be at the market and will keep sales open until Sunday night at 11:59pm for purchases online.
3. Merchandise – Jessica Gallia said that new hats are coming in and said to come check them out at the market. There are a few more sweatshirts available. An order form will go out next week for a hoodie and beanie.
4. Sponsorships – Shane Mikulencak said that Austin Orthodontics just committed to a 2-year sponsorship. He said to let him know if anyone knows of any businesses that would like to sponsor the program. He said there will be a Grand Slam, Triple, Double and Single sponsors this year as well as others.

He thanked everyone for praying for Quinn. The issue will be fixed with tubing to cover the sharp edges.

The baseball tryout meeting for the players will be 12/4 at 4:30pm in the Dragon's Lair. The meeting will go over what paperwork is needed and talk about important dates. Tryouts start January 17th and go through January 22nd right after school until around 8pm. They should have enough information that Wednesday to make decisions.

At the meeting on Wednesday, January 8th, there will be a Parent Q&A packet with dates, schedules, and information about tryouts.

The field will be overseeded on 11/22. The boys need to stay off the field. There will be signs posted.

The game schedule is pretty much complete. The Leander scrimmage will be on President's Day.

A work day will be scheduled for some time in December, possibly the Saturday before final exams.

The players have requested a radio in the PDC, the system needs to have Bluetooth. Groff said they could have the speakers in the old gym. They just need to get them down.
