

RRHS DRAGON BASEBALL BOOSTER CLUB **2025 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**

PURPOSE: The purpose of the RRHS Baseball Scholarship is to recognize the accomplishments of the senior Dragon baseball players.

AMOUNT OF AWARDS: The total amount of the scholarships awarded varies from year to year based upon available funds from the RRHS Dragon Baseball Booster Club and number of applicants that meet the scholarship criteria.

ELIGIBILITY:

1. The senior player/manager/trainer must have been in the RRHS Baseball Program for a minimum of two years, one of which has to be his/her senior year.
2. The senior must have an overall grade point average of 3.0 or higher after the fall semester of his senior year (on unweighted 4.0 scale).
3. The senior must plan to attend a two or four-year college after graduation from RRHS.
4. The senior must complete the RRHS Baseball Booster Club Scholarship Application along with an essay and submit it to Coach Carter by the deadline date.
5. A family member or guardian of the applicant must have been a member of the RRHS Baseball Booster Club for each year the player was a member of Dragon Baseball.

DEADLINE: The RRHS Baseball Booster Club 2025 Scholarship Application must be turned in to Tiffany Horvath by Friday, March 7, 2025.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Scholarships are valid for one year from the date of the award. If not used within one year, the recipient forfeits the scholarship in its entirety.
- The Scholarship Committee is composed of non-senior RRHS Baseball Booster Club parents who will review and verify the submitted scholarship applications.
- Scholarships will be awarded at the RRHS Senior Awards Assembly.

2. The senior must have an overall grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale or higher at the end of the fall semester in his senior year.
3. The senior must plan to attend a two year or a four year school after graduation from RRHS.
4. The senior must complete the RRHS Baseball Booster Club Application including essay and submit by the stated deadline.
5. A family member or guardian of the applicant must have been a member of the RRHS Baseball Booster Club for each year the player was a member of Dragon Baseball.
